Dear parents, children, staff, and parishioners,

Good Luck Year 6

We wish our Year 6 children lots of good luck as they undertake their Statutory Attainment Tests (SATS) over the next week in Reading, Grammar, Punctuation, Spelling and Mathematics. The children are all invited into school for breakfast from 8.15am (Monday - Thursday) to help settle their nerves and give them a hearty start to the day ahead. I hope the children have all managed to read the letter that myself and Mrs Priest have written to you all today — we meant every word! You really are amazing and we are SO proud of you!

A snippet of our message to Year 6:

'At the moment, you have been completing a lot of English and Maths work in preparation for these tests, but we also know you have a lot of other skills. Not every skill is taught in school and not all skills are tested. You might be a great footballer, fantastic at acting or possess greenfingers. You might be a people-person, a problem solver or a poet. Unfortunately, the tests you have been studying for are not designed to show off all of these amazing skills. They don't test whether you are a creative person, can code complex ICT systems, whether you possess the most amazing 'bottle flipping' skills or can do a handstand for longer than 10 seconds! They don't test your speaking skills or whether you can mend anything put in front of you. They don't measure whether you're arty, sporty or scientific.'

'Passing your SATs in English and Maths will not define you. The big things, the most important things are things like your personality, what you believe and think, your ideas and that spark inside of you are what make you unique and make you, you. Over the past year you have shown us how thoughtful, considerate, friendly and how quite simply amazing you all are, and as teachers we are so privileged to have had the chance to work with you all.'

Good luck children — you have all worked so hard, with such positive attitudes and I know that you will shine!

Please can I remind ALL Year 6 parents that children must attend school for the whole week and must not be absent, have any appointments or be away on holiday.

Special Intention Prayer Time

This week, as a school, we held a 'Special Intention' liturgy in each class. We hold these when we have something in particular we wish to pray for as a school community. This time, our special liturgy was dedicated to the children in Year 6. We all prayed for God to watch over them as they prepare to undertake their tests next week. Each child was then given the name of a child in Year 6 to pray for and has made them something special to open ahead of their tests next week to show that they are thinking of them. It was a lovely example of how, although each prayer time took place in individual classrooms and we were not together physically, that we were in fact united by faith and our togetherness was confirmed by the joining of our prayers.



<u> Holiday Requests</u>

Please may I remind you that our school policy makes it clear that we **do not** authorise term time holidays. Can I encourage you to plan any holidays around school breaks and **not** to take children out of school during term time. Every day your child attends school is very important.

Please remember if you proceed with an unauthorised holiday, the Local Authority may be informed and issue a Penalty Notice. This is currently £60 per parent per child, to be paid within 21 days (the fine doubles to £120 per parent per child after 21 days).

We do hope that you will continue to work in partnership with us.
